

March USCF-Rated G/30 Quads Thursday, March 8, 2012

The Ozaukee Regional Chess Association (ORCA) is offering a low-cost opportunity for chess players to play three USCF-rated games under tournament conditions. On Thursday evening, March 8, ORCA will offer G/30 rated quads to USCF members. These will be held in conjunction with the monthly Thursday Knights gathering in Mequon.

- **Registration:** 6:30 PM to 6:50 PM at the site or in advance to: admin@orcachess.org.
- **When:** Round 1 will begin promptly at 7:00 PM. Subsequent rounds will begin immediately after prior round results are recorded and pairings are produced.
- **Format:** 4-player sections grouped by rating (play 3 games, one against each of the other players in the section). Note: TD reserves the right to change the format to a 3-round Swiss System depending on the number of entries. USCF rules apply (clock, touch-move, notation, etc.)
- **Time Control:** G/30 D/5 (each player has 30 minutes to complete the game). Digital clocks preferred – set at G/30 with a 5-second delay.
- **Dual-rated:** Results will affect your Regular and Quick USCF ratings.
- **Entry Fee:** \$3.00 (\$1.00 for ORCA members). Cash or check only. Make checks payable to “Ozaukee Regional Chess Association”.
- **Prizes:** None – net proceeds after paying rating fees go to support ORCA.
- **Location:** Christ Perks café at Christ Church

- **TD:** Tom Hudson. Pairings done using WinTD software.
